

# ***EXPLOITING WEB RESOURCES FOR ELT***

The Web is a fun place to be with plenty of information and interactive features. Spanning the entire globe, the volume of information on the Web is amazing. One of the great things about the Web is that it allows us to *do* things rather than just sit and read. This course will find EL teachers performing web-wide tasks on existing web resources for the EL classroom. Teachers will have the opportunity to develop relevant and meaningful tasks and activities using online instructional materials, providing their students with authentic learning experiences.

## ***Objectives***

At the end of the course, the participants would have:

- explored various search engines and refined search strategies
- explored a range of web resources available on the WWW
- designed and developed a range of tasks and activities based on the web resources.

## ***Content***

The content of the course will be as follows:

- Effective use of search engines and refining search strategy skills
- Explore the potential of the WWW as a resource for language learning
- Design and develop tasks and activities based on the web-based resources

## ***Duration***

4 days (22 hours)

## ***Modes of Delivery***

Participants will engage in workshops, demonstrations, project analysis and presentations. At the end of the course, they will have produced a series of tasks and activities for the relevant web resources.
