Objectives:

The objectives of the programme are to:

- explore the effective use of technology in the classroom
- focus on ways in which teachers and students can use technology to enhance learning through research, communication, and productivity strategies and tools
- emphasize “hands-on” learning and the creation of curricular units and evaluation tools
- promote engaging opportunities for students through access to technology
- encourage teachers to work in teams, problem solve and participate in peer review of their units
